

Handoff (Continuity) Guide

- 1: Shutdown the Mac
- 2: While holding the Command and R keys, turn on the Mac and continue to hold the two keys until you see the progress bar, which indicates Recovery Mode is starting.
- 3: Click on 'Utilities' on the top bar.
- 4: Click on 'Terminal'
- 5: Type the phrase and hit return to disable SIP: `csrutil disable; reboot`
- 6: Wait for the machine to reboot (might take a moment as it might say: *'busy updating; waiting for lock'*)
- 7: Open the App Store (or, for newer macOS versions, System Preferences > Software Update) and check for updates and install all of them. Continue to do this until there are no more updates available. (May require several restarts and subsequent checking for new updates upon each boot up).
- 8: Run our provided bash script to enable Handoff (Continuity) ([download link here](#)). You may need to right-click and select 'Open With', and then choose the 'Terminal' application in the 'Utilities' folder. The script will prompt you to enter in your password.
- 9: Shutdown the Mac (do not click restart)
- 10: Boot the Mac
- 11: Do NOT re-enable SIP. If you re-enabled it and everything seems to work fine, then disregard. However, we've found that re-enabling SIP had disabled Handoff features randomly on some of our test machines.
